
Hob Separator Plate

NOTE: Ensure packaging is disposed of in a safe environmentally friendly way


Separator plate may not allow use of internal storage drawer sets


When fitting a hob into a worktop, a heat resistant separator plate is required to isolate the underside of the hob (unless above an oven).

Note: The plate must allow ventilation for the hob and be easily removed for any service needs.

This assembly guide shows an example method of fitting a separator plate.



When fitting granite worktops, the front rail of the cabinet will need to be routered (3mm in depth) at set intervals to allow for airflow (as above timber / laminate worktop method is not possible).

Note: Do not router the full length of the front rail, as this is required as support for the granite worktop.

Depending upon application a granite support bar may need to be fitted if front rail is reduced in size (and strength) significantly.

Cut out as necessary for gas pipe connection etc.
