

Looking after your Tap

To keep your tap in perfect condition, we recommend marks and stains are removed as soon as possible.



Recommendations

- Clean regularly with hot, soapy water and a soft or microfibre cloth
- For brushed finish taps, always clean your tap along the grain of the scratch pattern
- Soaked cotton wool, a nylon scratch pad or toothbrush can be used on difficult areas
- Dry the tap after every use to prevent future build up of limescale
- To remove limescale deposits use a 50% mix of water and white wine vinegar and rinse thoroughly afterwards



Avoid

- Harsh household chemicals such as oven cleaners, drain cleaners, rust removers, paint strippers etc
- · Abrasive cloths and cleaners
- Solvents, chlorinated solvents, ketones, acetones, scouring cleaners and acidic cleaners
- Leaving white vinegar in contact with the surface
