
















MAKE SURE EXISTING TIMBER SUB-FLOORS ARE SECURE





DPM 🥌 Always install a DPM where there are concerns over moisture in the sub-floor



Breathable moisture barrier i.e - Bitumen moisture barrier paper can be used










Water and electric\* systems can be used


